



Disaster Preparation Check-list for People with Pets

If you have animals in your care, your planning and preparation for a disaster or emergency will require more detail. If you have not already done so, please take time to create a plan so that your animals will be more likely to survive with less stress. Your animals are depending on you.

- Family emergency preparedness plan
- NOAA All-Hazard Radio
- Disaster preparedness kit
- Copies of health certificates
- Crate and bedding
- Current medical and vaccination records
- Current photos
- Detailed instructions for animal care and for rescue workers
- Disinfectant including 1-gallon bleach
- Extra daily medications and/or copies of prescriptions with current expiration date
- First aid kit
- Flashlights, extra batteries
- Flat tire repair kit
- Food, water (1 gallon/person/day + ½ gallon/pet/day, manual can opener, and dishes
- Identification tags
- Muzzles, gauze rolls
- Out-of-state telephone contact
- Pet comfort items: towels, blankets, toys
